approving the regulations on iron-fortified wheat flour

In light of the Constitution;

In light of decree no. 2003-326 of 19 December 2003 regarding the exercise of regulatory power;

In light of decree no. 2003-114 of 7 July 2003 regarding remittances to the Minister of Commerce, Consumption and Supplies;

In light of decree no. 2009-402 of 13 October 2009 regarding remittances to the Minister of Health and the Population;

In light of decree no. 2010-316 of 28 April 2010 regarding remittances to the Minister of Industrial Development and Private Sector Promotion;

In light of decree no. 2012-1035 of 25 September 2012 nominating members of the Government.

Order:

First Article: The purpose of the present order is to approve the regulations on iron-fortified wheat flour destined for human consumption, code NCGO 001-2013-0406.

Article 2: To be declared iron-fortified wheat flour, the flour must contain 60 ppm of iron in the form of ferrous fumarate or ferrous sulphate.

Article 3: The regulations on iron-fortified wheat flour as well as the specific characteristics thereof are obtained from the general managers of the industry.

The modalities of obtaining that information are determined via order by the Minister responsible for the industry.

Article 4: The regulations on iron-fortified wheat flour can be modified, revised, or repealed if their application is found to compromise health, security or protection of life and the environment.

The modification, revision, or repeal of the regulations on iron-fortified wheat flour is established via order by the Minister responsible for the industry.

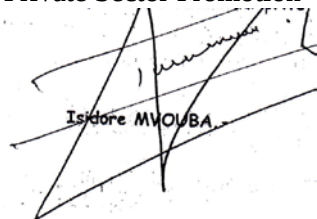
Article 5: Within six months of the date of signature of the present order, the importers of iron-fortified wheat flour must conform to the prescriptions of the regulations on iron-fortified wheat flour.

Article 6: Violations of the present order are punished in accordance with the laws and regulations in force.

Article 7: The present order will be registered and published in the official Journal of the Republic of the Congo.

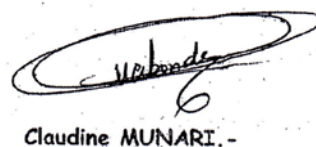

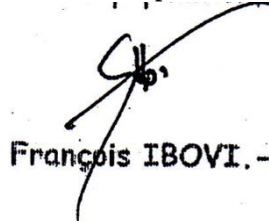
